The following instructions apply to all HPC's 'How To...' software CD's. In the following instructions, when we refer to the HT folder, we will be referring to that folder designated HT_xxx1 on your computer screen.

PC Startup Instructions

It is assumed that your PC is up and running Windows® 95, 98, or NT and that you have either the Microsoft® Internet Explorer™ or Netscape® browser, and Acrobat® Reader 4.0, and Quicktime® 4.1 installed. **If you do not have a browser, Acrobat, and Quicktime installed on your computer, please see the directions below on installing the appropriate program needed.**

1. Make sure all other applications are closed.
2. Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive (most commonly D:).
3. Double click on the "My Computer" icon.
4. Double click on the CD which is in your CD-ROM Drive.
5. Copy the "HT" folder by dragging and dropping it onto your desktop.
6. Close all open windows and applications.
7. Double click on the "HT" folder that is now on your desktop.
8. Double click on the "start.pdf" or "start" file to begin the 'How to...' guide.

Browser Installation (if applicable)

PC Browser Installation

1. Make sure all other applications are closed.
2. Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive (most commonly D:).
3. Double click on the "My Computer" icon.
4. Double click on the CD which is in your CD-ROM Drive.
5. Double click on the folder named "Download".
6. Double click on the folder named "Browsers".
7. Double click on the folder named "PC Browsers".
8. Double click on "Netscape.exe" or "Netscape", then follow the on-screen installation instructions.
9. Restart your computer if directed in the browser installation instructions.

Quicktime® 4.1 Installation

Quicktime Installation for PC

1. Make sure all other applications are closed.
2. Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive (most commonly D:).
3. Double click on the "My Computer" icon.
4. Double click on the CD which is in your CD-ROM Drive.
5. Double click on the folder named "Download".
6. Double click on the folder named "quicktime".

7. Double click on the folder named "pc".
8. Double click on "QuicktimeInstaller.exe" or "QuicktimeInstaller", then follow the on-screen installation instructions. (Note: Quicktime registration is not needed. Click on the 'next' button to skip.)
9. We recommend selecting the "Full" install to insure proper installation. (Note: During the installation of Quicktime 4.1 you may encounter errors. Click ignore and the rest of the installation will be complete.)

Acrobat® Reader 4.0 Installation

Acrobat Installation for PC

1. Make sure all other applications are closed.
2. Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive (most commonly D:).
3. Double click on the "My Computer" icon.
4. Double click on the CD which is in your CD-ROM Drive.
5. Double click on the folder named "Download".
6. Double click on the folder named "acrobat".
7. Double click on the folder named "pc".
8. Double click on the "Ar40eng.exe" or "Ar40eng" icon, then follow the on-screen installation instructions.

MAC Startup Instructions

It is assumed that your Mac® is up and running and that you have either the Microsoft® Internet Explorer™ or Netscape® browser, and Acrobat® Reader 4.0, and Quicktime® 4.1 installed. **If you do not have a browser, Acrobat, and Quicktime installed on your computer, please see the directions below on installing the appropriate program needed.**

1. Close all windows and applications.
2. Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive.
3. Double click on the CD which is in your CD-ROM Drive.
4. Copy the "HT" folder by dragging and dropping it onto your desktop.
5. Double click on the "HT" folder that is now on your desktop.
6. Double click on the "start.pdf" or "start" file to begin the 'How to...' guide.

Browser Installation (if applicable)

MAC Browser Installation

1. Make sure all other applications are closed.
2. Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive.
3. Double click on the CD which is in your CD-ROM Drive.
4. Double click on the folder named "Download".
5. Double click on the folder named "Browsers".
6. Double click on the folder named "Mac® Browsers".
7. You will find both the Netscape® and the Internet Explorer Browsers™ in this folder. You need only to install one browser on your system, so install the browser of your choice.
8. Double click on the icon of either browser and follow the on-screen installation instructions.
9. Restart your computer if directed in the browser installation instructions.

Quicktime Installation for MAC

1. Make sure all other applications are closed.
2. Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive.
3. Double click on the CD which is in your CD-ROM Drive.
4. Double click on the folder named "Download".
5. Double click on the folder named "quicktime".
6. Double click on the folder named "mac".
7. Double click on the "Quicktime Installer" icon and follow the on-screen installation instructions. (Note: Quicktime registration is not needed. Click on the 'next' button to skip.)
8. We recommend selecting the "Full" install to insure proper installation.
9. Restart your computer as directed in the quicktime installation instructions.

Acrobat Installation for MAC

1. Make sure all other applications are closed.
2. Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive.
3. Double click on the CD which is in your CD-ROM Drive.
4. Double click on the folder named "Download".
5. Double click on the folder named "acrobat".
6. Double click on the folder named "mac".
7. Double click on the "Reader Installer" icon, then follow the on screen installation instructions.
